### What is STARBASE?

Kansas STARBASE is a premier youth educational program of the U.S. Department of Defense. Our goal is to motivate students in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM). With our "hands-on, minds-on" approach, students are engaged and encouraged to pursue careers in STEM.

### **School Year Academies**

DoD STARBASE focuses on elementary students, **primarily fifth graders.** STARBASE serves students who are historically under-represented in STEM. The STARBASE school year program is a 5-day experience designed to deliver curriculum that meets national STEM standards. The program is delivered at no-cost to the participating schools though the schools are responsible for any transportation costs to the National Guard Armory in Manhattan, KS. ## STARBASE Advanced

STARBASE Manhattan continues the STEM mission by providing after-school clubs for Middle School students building on the concepts taught at the elementary level. These clubs are designed to enhance student engagement in STEM subjects. STARBASE is able to provide staff, support, and the necessary equipment for students to engage in hands-on STEM investigations.
